

# Moorhead I-94 Corridor Study

## Phase One Engagement Summary

The first phase of engagement was focused on investigating and listening to the public on their perception on the corridor. The following is a summary of what we heard from the various engagement opportunities.

### Key Themes



77.9% think weather, crashes, or construction cause negative impacts to travel time on the corridor

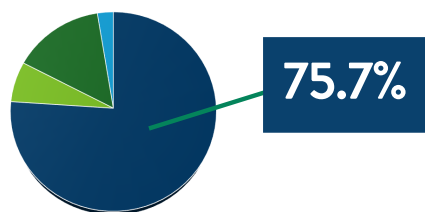


57.1% feel access ramps to adjacent neighborhoods and business need improvement



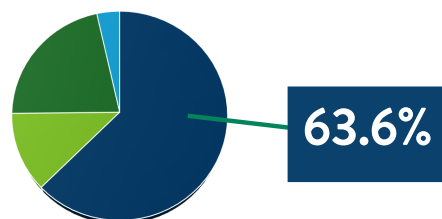
64.4% feel speed changes were not needed 57.1% respondents have crash concerns about driving the corridor

### What They Would Change?

In the survey respondents were asked about what they would change and their concerns, the most common themes were:

- Adding lanes, specifically a third in each direction would reduce congestion.
- On and Off Ramp improvements at 20th St and Highway 336 would increase safety and allow smoother traffic flow.
- Relocating the rest area could be beneficial for the community.
- Roadway maintenance was a concern based on observed winter driving conditions.

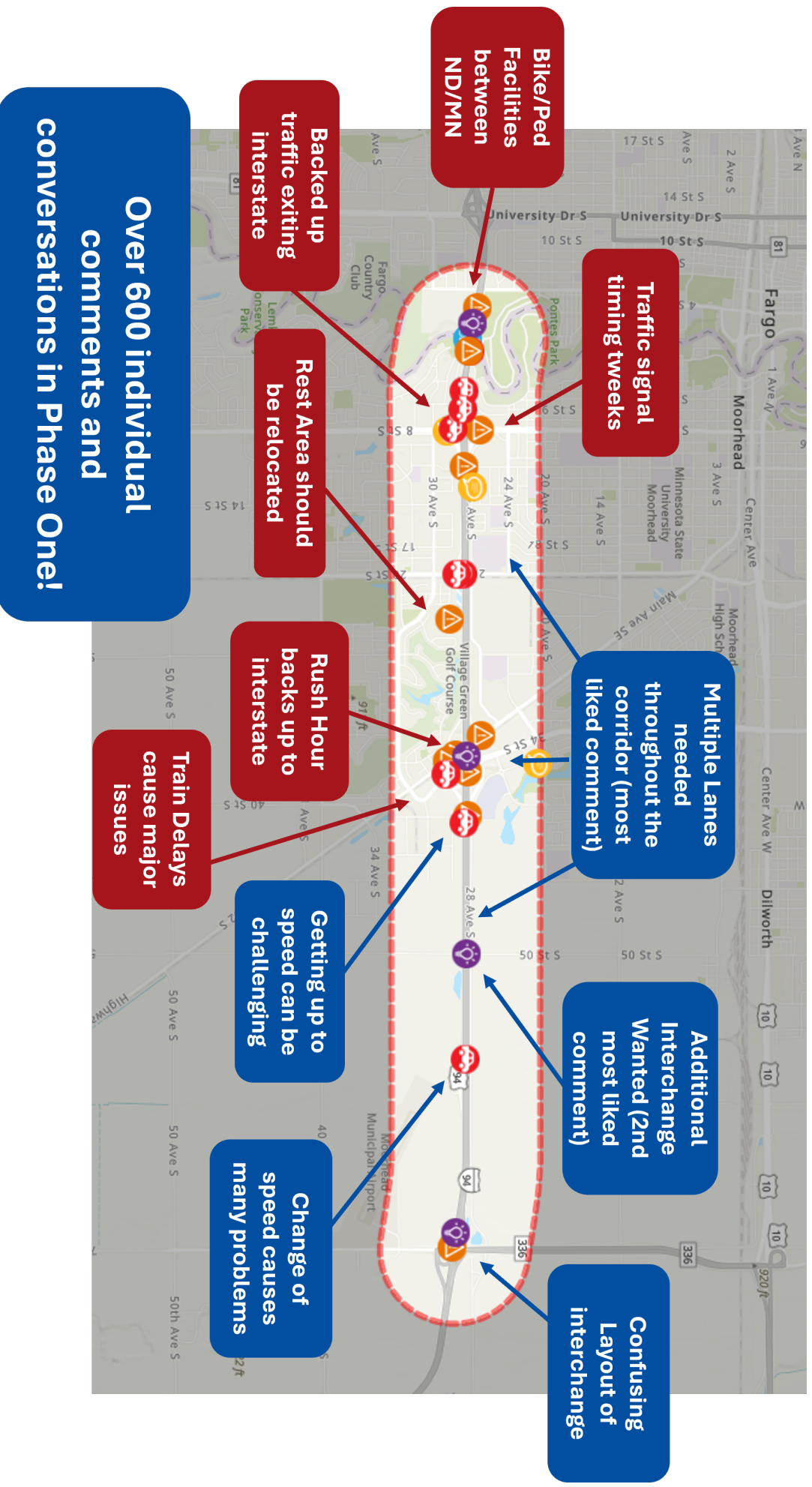


Figure: Interactive Map Comment Themes
